PLUMBERS: Provides relative to licensure of plumbers

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 37:1361(B)(introductory paragraph) and (4), 1366(A)(1) and (L),
3	1367(A)(1), 1368(A)(1)(introductory paragraph), 1371(A)(1), 1373(A), 1377(B), and
4	1378(A)(3), (6), and (8), relative to licensure of plumbers; to provide for residential
5	plumbers; to provide for board appointments; to provide for duties of the board; to
6	provide for licensure requirements; to provide for the issuance of licenses; to provide
7	relative to fees; to provide for injunctions; to provide for definitions; to provide for
8	disciplinary actions; and to provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
0	Section 1. R.S. 37:1361(B)(introductory paragraph) and (4), 1366(A)(1) and (L),
1	1367(A)(1), 1368(A)(1)(introductory paragraph), 1371(A)(1), 1373(A), 1377(B), and
12	1378(A)(3), (6), and (8) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

26	existing plumbing in one- and two-family dwellings, without the supervision of a

10	(2) Tradesman Residential plumber. A "tradesman residential plumber" is
11	a natural person who possesses the necessary qualifications and knowledge to install,
12	alter, repair, and maintain existing plumbing systems and is licensed by the board to

14	dwellings at the direction of a master plumber, without the supervision of a

Abstract: Provides for the licensing and qualifications of a residential plumber and discontinues the tradesman plumber limited license.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1361(B)) creates the State Plumbing Board (board) and provides for the appointment of members, including three master plumbers, three journeyman plumbers, and one tradesman plumber.

<u>Proposed law retains present law</u> but changes the appointment of the tradesman plumber \underline{to} a residential plumber.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1366(A)(1) and (L)) provides that any person engaged in the duties of a tradesman plumber shall possess a tradesman plumber limited license. <u>Present law</u> further requires the board to assist the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges in developing training for the tradesman plumber limited license.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and changes tradesman plumber limited license <u>to</u> residential plumber limited license.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1367(A)(1)) prohibits a natural person from engaging in the work of a tradesman plumber without a license. <u>Present law</u> further provides that a tradesman plumber may independently repair existing plumbing of one- and two-family dwellings without supervision.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and changes tradesman plumber limited license <u>to</u> residential plumber limited license. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that a residential plumber may independently install, alter, repair, and maintain plumbing in one- and two-family dwellings without supervision.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1368(A)(1)) requires the board to issue a tradesman plumber limited license to any person who meets the certain qualifications.

 $\underline{\text{Proposed law}}$ retains present law and changes tradesman plumber limited license $\underline{\text{to}}$ residential plumber limited license.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1371(A)(1)) allows the board to fix and charge reasonable examination, licensing, and renewal fees for tradesman plumbers.

<u>Proposed law retains present law</u> and changes tradesman plumbers to residential plumbers.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1373(A)) allows the board to enjoin any person from engaging in doing the work of a tradesman plumber.

Proposed law retains present law and changes tradesman plumber to residential plumber.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1377(B)(1)) defines "journeyman plumber" as a person who possesses the necessary qualifications and knowledge to install, alter, or repair plumbing systems.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that a journeyman plumber possesses the necessary qualifications to maintain plumbing systems.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1377(B)(2)) defines "tradesman plumber" as a natural person who possesses the necessary qualifications and knowledge to repair existing plumbing systems.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes "tradesman plumber" <u>to</u> "residential plumber" and provides that a residential plumber is a natural person who possesses the necessary qualifications and knowledge to install, alter, repair, and maintain plumbing systems.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 37:1378(A)(3), (6), and (8)) provides for certain disciplinary actions of tradesman plumbers.

<u>Proposed law retains present law</u> and changes tradesman plumbers to residential plumbers.
