CRIME/MISDEMEANOR

OR INCREASE LF RV See Note

Prohibits a person from engaging in picketing at the residence or dwelling of an individual

<u>Current law</u> provides for the definition and applicable penalties for disturbing the peace. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that no person shall petition, picket, demonstrate, or assemble with other persons near an individual's residence in a manner which interferes, disrupts, threatens to disrupt, or harasses the individual's right to control, use or enjoy his residence; assesses a fine of no more than \$500 for its violation; provides that each day on which a violation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> will likely result in an indeterminable increase in local revenues as a result of fines for those convicted of petitioning, picketing, demonstrating, or assembling with others near an individual's residence in a manner which interferes, disrupts, threatens to disrupt, or harasses an individual's right to control, use, or enjoy his residence. The exact fiscal impact of the passage of this legislation on local revenue is indeterminable because the amount in fines that would be imposed on those convicted may vary. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority.
