If Effective January 1, 2025, if the applicant is eligible to vote absentee by mail pursuant to R.S. 18:1303(F), (I), or (J), his application, if such application meets the 11 requirements of this Section, may remain valid indefinitely for each annual statewide 12 13 election cycle, which shall be defined as all elections from January first through 14 December thirty-first of that same year upon request of the applicant, unless an absentee by mail ballot that has been sent to the applicant is returned to the registrar as undeliverable. 15 If the applicant's absentee by mail ballot is returned to the registrar as undeliverable, the 16 registrar shall send notice by forwardable mail to such applicant that his application will no 17 18 longer be valid, and the applicant shall be required to submit a new application to the 19 registrar that meets the requirements of this Section and provide a current address before the 20 applicant will be eligible to vote absentee by mail again pursuant to this Section. 21
