10 (iii) Relevant strategies for care regarding HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis and
11 HIV post-exposure prophylaxis for uninsured patients."

13 On page 3, delete lines 1 and 2 in their entirety

14 AMENDMENT NO. 16

15 On page 3, line 3, after "(b)" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof
16 "Document a focused assessment of the patient following best practices and guidelines for
17 preventing HIV."

18 AMENDMENT NO. 17

19 On page 3, delete lines 4 and 5 in their entirety

20 AMENDMENT NO. 18

21 On page 3, line 6, after "(c)" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof
22 "Document steps to obtain consent, order, process, evaluate, interpret, and discuss results
23 with patients of any laboratory tests listed in the protocol."

24 AMENDMENT NO. 19

25 On page 3, delete lines 7 through 21 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

26 "(d) Identify the nature and obligations for successful HIV pre-exposure
27 prophylaxis or HIV post-exposure prophylaxis, as required by the patient, and the
28 importance of timely testing for HIV and related complications and comorbid
29 conditions."

30 AMENDMENT NO. 20

31 On page 3, at the beginning of line 27, insert "A."

32 AMENDMENT NO. 21

33 On page 4, after line 3, insert the following:

34 "B. This Section shall not be construed to require a health coverage plan or
35 a third-party administrator or pharmacy benefit manager to reimburse a pharmacist
36 or pharmacy as an in-network or a preferred provider.

37 C. The provisions of this Section shall apply to coverage under a group
38 health coverage plan provided to a resident of this state regardless of whether the

1 health coverage plan policy, contract, or other agreement is delivered, issued for
2 delivery, or renewed in this state."
