2	To amend and reenact R.S. 15:569(A) as amended by Section 1 of Act 5 of the 2024 Second
3	Extraordinary Session, relative to execution of a death sentence; to provide relative
4	to methods of execution; to remove nitrogen hypoxia as a permissible method of
5	execution; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 15:569(A) as amended by Section 1 of Act 5 of the 2024 Second
8	Extraordinary Session is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§569. Place for execution of death sentence; manner method of execution
10	A. Every sentence of death executed in this state prior to September 15, 1991,
11	shall be by electrocution, that is, causing to pass through the body of the person
12	convicted a current of electricity of sufficient intensity to cause death, and the
13	application and continuance of such current through the body of the person convicted
14	until such person is dead. Every sentence of death imposed in this state shall be
15	executed at the Louisiana State Penitentiary at Angola. Every execution shall be
16	made in a room entirely cut off from view of all except those permitted by law to be
17	in said the room. At the discretion of the secretary of the Department of Public

	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024; if vetoed by the governor		
	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day		
5	following such approval by the legislature or July 1, 2024, whichever is later.

<u>Present law</u> as amended by Acts 2024, 2nd Ex. Sess., No.5, §1, eff. July 1, 2024, provides that every sentence of death will be carried out using intravenous injection, nitrogen hypoxia, or electrocution.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes nitrogen hypoxia as a permissible method of execution and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

Effective July 1, 2024.
