**Abstract:** Provides an exception to compliance with certain local ordinances on flood control for integrated coastal protection plans included in the state's local master plan.

Present law requires each state agency, and each public and quasi-public agency of the state, except those with respect to the construction and maintenance of bridges and highways comply with all ordinances, rules, and regulations, including zoning and land use regulations, adopted by any parish or municipality of the state pursuant to the authority of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968.

Proposed law adds an exception to present law for integrated coastal protection projects included in the state's local master plan.

Provides that C.C. Art. 6 of this Act is interpretive and remedial and shall be given prospective and retroactive application.
