2	To enact R.S. 15:1352(A)(71) through (80), relative to the crime of racketeering; to provide
3	for additional crimes that are elements of racketeering activity; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 15:1352(A)(71) through (80) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1352. Definitions
8	A. As used in this Chapter, "racketeering activity" means committing,
9	attempting to commit, conspiring to commit, or soliciting, coercing, or intimidating
10	another person to commit any crime that is punishable under the following
11	provisions of Title 14 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, the Uniform
12	Controlled Dangerous Substances Law, or the Louisiana Securities Law:

- (4) Simple arson of a religious building.
- (5) Manufacture and possession of delayed incendiary devices.
- (6) Manufacture and possession of a bomb.
- (7) Aggravated criminal damage to property.
- (8) Criminal damage to historic buildings or landmarks by defacing with graffiti.
- (9) Criminal damage to a critical infrastructure.
- (10) Bank fraud.
