Abstract: Adds certain offenses as elements of the crime of racketeering activity.

Present law provides for a list of offenses that constitute elements of "racketeering activity".

Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law adds the following offenses as elements of the crime of racketeering activity:

- (1) Rioting.
- (2) Inciting to riot.
- (3) Injury by arson.
- (4) Simple arson of a religious building.
- (5) Manufacture and possession of delayed incendiary devices.
- (6) Manufacture and possession of a bomb.
- (7) Aggravated criminal damage to property.
- (8) Criminal damage to historic buildings or landmarks by defacing with graffiti.
- (9) Criminal damage to a critical infrastructure.
- (10) Bank fraud.

(Adds R.S. 15:1352(A)(71)-(80))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House
