**HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Representative Glorioso to Engrossed House Bill No. 510 by Representative Glorioso

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 18, change "(3)" to "(3)(a)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, between lines 2 and 3, insert the following:

5 "(b) At a minimum, the commissioner shall include in the form described in  
6 this Paragraph the following information in boldfaced type no smaller than eighteen  
7 point font:

8 "PLEASE READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY BECAUSE IT AFFECTS  
9 YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS, REQUIRES YOU TO ARBITRATE DISPUTES, AND  
10 LIMITS THE MANNER IN WHICH YOU CAN SEEK RELIEF.

11 Arbitration is a process in which persons with a dispute waive their rights to  
12 file a lawsuit, proceed in court, and have a jury trial to resolve their disputes and,  
13 instead, agree to submit their disputes to a neutral third person (an "arbitrator") for  
14 a final decision. Each party to the dispute has an opportunity to present some  
15 evidence to the arbitrator. Pre-arbitration discovery may be limited. Arbitration  
16 proceedings are private and less formal than court trials. The arbitrator will issue a  
17 final and binding decision resolving the dispute, which may be enforced as a court  
18 judgment. Your appeal rights may be limited as a court rarely overturns an  
19 arbitrator's decision."
