FLOODING/CONTROL: Names the Lake Borgne Surge Barrier after President George W. Bush

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 38:327.1, relative to the naming of a flood control structure; to provide for the
3 naming of a surge barrier to honor a former president; and to provide for related
4 matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 38:327.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §327.1. Lake Borgne Surge Barrier; memorial

8 Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 42:267 or any other law to the
9 contrary, the Lake Borgne Surge Barrier, otherwise known as the "Great Wall of
10 Louisiana" shall be named the President George W. Bush Surge Barrier.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House
