Each 10 The secretary of state's website shall also include instructions on how a voter may subscribe to receive electronic notifications of polling place location changes. If a 11 parish registrar of voters or clerk of court maintains a website, he shall publish on 12 the website beginning thirty days prior to an election a publicly available list of the 13
- 14 locations of all polling places within the parish, arranged by precinct."
