25	(3) The monies in the Seafood Promotion and Marketing Fund shall be used
26	by the Seafood Promotion and Marketing Board for the following purposes:
27	(a) To sample, analyze, test, and monitor raw seafood products of foreign
28	origin that are imported into Louisiana and stored on the premises of any business
29	holding a commercial seafood permit issued pursuant to R.S. 40:31.35 in order to
30	detect substances that are harmful to human health. All monies deposited into the
31	fund from the fee collected pursuant to R.S. 40:31.35(C) shall be used for this
32	purpose. The board shall coordinate with the commissioner of agriculture and
33	forestry to implement this Subparagraph.

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1	(b) To otherwise to implement the duties and functions of the that board
2	relating to the promotion and marketing of seafood as provided in R.S. 56:578.3 in
3	the amounts appropriated each year to the Department of Culture, Recreation and
4	Tourism by the legislature for the use by the board.
