HB 623 Reengrossed

Abstract: Provides for the nomination of certain board members to the State Licensing Board for Contractors by the presiding officers of the legislature and appointment by the governor.

Present law provides that at least two members of the board shall be appointed from a list of four names submitted by the American Subcontractors Association of Louisiana.

Present law further provides that these members shall have had the greater part of their experience as a subcontractor in the construction industry in fields other than electrical or mechanical construction.

Proposed law changes present law and provides that two members shall be appointed by the governor pursuant to the following conditions:

- (1) One member shall be nominated from a list of three members of the La. Concrete Assoc. by the speaker of the House of Representatives and shall have the greater part of his experience as a licensed concrete contractor.
- (2) One member shall be nominated from a list of three members of the American Subcontractors Assoc. of La. by the president of the Senate and shall have the greater part of his experience as a subcontractor.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Commerce to the original bill:

1. Add that the House speaker's list of three nominees shall be La. Concrete Association members.
2. Add that the Senate president's list of three nominees shall be American Subcontractors Association of La. members.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Make technical changes to improve readability.
