Abstract: Prohibits the use of "construction management at risk" for projects that cost less than two million dollars for hospital service districts.

Present law prohibits "construction management at risk" (CMAR) from being used for any project that is estimated to cost less than \$5,000,000.

Proposed law adds an exception for hospital service districts as defined by present law, which may not use CMAR for projects that cost less than \$2,000,000.

Proposed law removes the requirement in present law for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the original bill:

1. Remove the requirement in present law for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.
