AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "R.S. 22:918(C)(1) and (2)," and insert "R.S. 22:918(B)(1) and
3 (C)(1) and (2) and to repeal R.S. 22:918(D)(5),"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "policies;" insert "to repeal relative to insurers' use of genetic
6 information contained in medical records;"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 6, delete "R.S. 22:918(C)(1) and (2)" and insert "R.S. 22:918(B)(1) and
9 (C)(1) and (2)"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 9, after "genetic" insert "research or testing"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 1, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

14 "B. An insurer, in determining eligibility for coverage, establishing
15 premiums, limiting coverage, or making any other underwriting decisions, shall not
16 do either of the following:

17 (1) Take into consideration the fact that an individual or a family member of
18 the individual participated in genetic research or testing, including any request for
19 or receipt of genetic services or participation by an individual or family member in
20 clinical research or testing that includes genetic services, unless the results of that
21 genetic research or test are ~~included in the individual's medical record~~ or provided
22 by the individual for consideration by the insurer.
