1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" insert "amend and reenact Children's Code Art. 905.1(G) and
3 908(C)(3) and to" and after "Code Art." change "804(1)(d)" to "905.1(H)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 6, after "Code Art." delete "804(1)(d)" and insert the following:

6 "905.1(G) and 908(C)(3) are hereby amended and reenacted and Children's Code
7 Art. 905.1(H)"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, delete lines 7 through 11, and insert the following:

10 "Art. 905.1. Academic plan for children committed to the Department of Public
11 Safety and Corrections

12 * * *

13 **G. For purposes of this Title, "individualized learning plan" shall include**
14 **vocational training.**

15 **H.** Upon discharge from the department's custody, a copy of the child's
16 academic plan and all progress reports shall be provided to the child's parents or
17 guardian. The department shall provide this information to the school or academic
18 program in which the child is thereafter enrolled upon written request.

20 Art. 908. Care and treatment by department

22 C. At least six months prior to the release of the child, the department shall
23 prepare a written, individualized, and thorough transitional plan developed in
24 collaboration with the child and any agency or department assuming his custody,
25 care, or responsibility.

27 (3) The transitional plan shall address the needs of the child, including but not
28 limited to education, health, permanent connections, living arrangements,
29 independent living skills, **vocational training**, and employment."
