21 "D.(1) In order to receive a special permit as a registered natural hair braider,
22 a person shall meet all of the following requirements:23 (a) Review training materials prepared by the board on sanitation.24 (b) Complete a self-test prepared by the board on sanitation and maintain the
25 self-test and training materials at the location where braiding is provided.26 (c) Complete the board's application for the natural hair braiding permit and
27 submit it by mail to the board.28 (d) Pay applicable fees not to exceed twenty-five dollars.29 (2) A person who holds a valid special permit issued pursuant to this
30 Subsection shall be exempt from all of the following requirements:31 (a) A certificate of registration for beauty shops or salons.32 (b) Renewal of the special permit.33 (c) Payment of additional fees for the maintenance of the permit.34 (d) Taking any additional examination.35 (3) The board shall make the training materials and self-test available at its
36 office and on its website.

1 (4) The board may visit any location in which hair braiding is performed at
2 any time during business hours to determine if the training materials and the
3 completed self-test are available."
