Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to Original Senate Bill No. 185 by Senator Seabaugh

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 13:4163(E)(2)(c)" insert "and (F)(3), (4), and (5)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 6, after "court costs;" insert "to provide for exceptions;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, after line 19, insert the following:

9 **(3) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to proceedings wherein a**
10 **temporary restraining order, protective order, preliminary injunction, permanent**
11 **injunction, court-approved consent agreement resulting from an action brought, or**
12 **order issued pursuant to any of the following:**

13 **(a) R.S. 46:2131 et seq., R.S. 46:2151, R.S. 46:2171 et seq., R.S. 46:2181 et seq.,**
14 **R.S. 9:361 et seq., R.S. 9:372, Children's Code Article 1564 et seq., Code of Civil**
15 **Procedure Articles 3604 and 3607.1, or peace bonds pursuant to Code of Criminal**
16 **Procedure Article 30(B).**

17 **(b) Code of Criminal Procedure Articles, including 871.1, regarding the**
18 **disposition, sentence, or bail condition of a criminal matter.**

19 **(c) R.S. 46:1846 to prohibit communications between offenders and victims**
20 **following a charge or after sentencing for any crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2,**
21 **felony sex offense as defined in R.S. 46:1844(W), felony human trafficking-related**
22 **offense as defined in R.S. 46:1844(W), or a felony offense committed upon a family**
23 **member, household member, or dating partner as defined by R.S. 46:2132, or upon an**
24 **immediate family member of such person.**

25 **(d) R.S. 15:574.4.2(A)(5) as condition of a parole release which requires that the**
26 **parolee stay away from any specific person, when the order is issued for the purpose**
27 **of preventing violent or threatening acts, harassment against, contact or**
28 **communication with, or physical proximity to, another person to prevent witness**
29 **intimidation, domestic abuse, stalking, dating violence, or sexual assault.**

30 **(4) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to proceedings pursuant to the**
31 **Domestic Violence Prevention Firearm Transfer Act and Code of Criminal Procedure**
32 **Article 1001, et seq.**

33 **(5) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to proceedings for writs of**
34 **habeas corpus for the determination and enforcement of rights to the custody of a**
35 **minor or for the release of a person in custody in which the family court has original**
36 **jurisdiction.**"
