FIRE PROTECT/FIREMEN: Provides relative to cancer screenings for certain firefighters and fire service employees

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 33:2581.4, relative to certain firefighters and fire service employees; to
3	provide relative to cancer screenings for such firefighters and employees; to provide
4	relative to the time period for cancer screening examinations; to provide relative to
5	screenings for retired firefighters and fire service employees; to provide for an
6	effective date; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 33:2581.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§2581.4. Cancer screenings; certain firefighters and fire service employees
10	A. A classified firefighter employed as a full-time paid employee of a
11	municipal or parish fire department or fire protection district and fire service
12	employees employed by a nonprofit corporation under contract with a fire protection
13	district shall be provided a cancer screening examination conducted by a physician
14	not less than three years after the start of employment and every three years
15	thereafter during the course of employment. The examination shall include but not
16	be limited to screening for the following cancers:
17	<u>(1) Colon.</u>
18	<u>(2) Lung.</u>

10	B. Any firefighter or fire service employee who retires from active service,		
11	including a firefighter or fire service employee who retires due to a disability, shall		
12	be provided cancer screening examinations by his former employer as provided in		
13	Subsection A of this Section.		
14	C. All costs associated with cancer screening examinations provided for in		
15	this Section shall be paid by the firefighters's or fire service employee's employer or		
16	former employer. No co payment, deductible, coinsurance, or any out-of-pocket		
17	expense shall be required for such examinations.		
18	D. No firefighter or fire service employee shall be required to participate in		
19	cancer screening examinations.		
20	E. The provisions of the Section shall not be applicable to any firefighter or		
21	fire service employee who resigned or was terminated by his employer.		
22	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not		
23	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature		
24	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If		
25	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become		
26	effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Requires that certain firefighters and fire service employees be provided cancer screening examinations.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that classified firefighters employed as full-time paid employees of municipal or parish fire departments or fire protection districts and fire service employees employed by nonprofit corporations under contract with fire protection districts be provided cancer screening examinations.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the cancer screenings examinations be conducted by a physician not less than three years after the start of employment and every three years thereafter during the course of employment.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the examination include, but not be limited to the following cancers:

- (1) Colon.
- (2) Lung.
- (3) Bladder.
- (4) Oral.
- (5) Thyroid.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that retired firefighters and fire service employees be provided cancer screening examinations by their former employers pursuant to <u>proposed law</u>. Additionally requires employers and former employers to pay for the costs of cancer screening examinations.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no firefighter or fire service employee shall be required to participate in cancer screening examinations. Further provides that <u>proposed law</u> is not applicable to any firefighter or fire service employee who resigned or was terminated by his employer.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

- 1. Remove provisions that make <u>proposed law</u> applicable to certain volunteer firefighters.
- 2. Add provisions to make <u>proposed law</u> inapplicable to firefighters and fire service employees who resigned or were terminated by their employer.
