2	To the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment to study wind and solar
3	energy development in Louisiana and to report its findings to the House of
4	Representatives prior to the convening of the 2025 Regular Session.
5	WHEREAS, wind and solar energy are emerging alternative energy sources; and
6	WHEREAS, the development of renewable energy sources, such as solar and wind
7	energy, has become increasingly important in reducing our reliance on fossil fuels and
8	protecting our environment; and
9	WHEREAS, the development of clean and renewable energy sources translates
10	directly into job creation, a reliable energy supply, lower energy costs, improved public
11	health, and a better environment; and
12	WHEREAS, the study of the development of wind and solar energy in Louisiana
13	would help inform decisionmaking on the statewide impact on the energy industry; and
14	WHEREAS, gathering comprehensive data and information on the feasibility,
15	economic impact, and environmental impact of the development of wind and solar energy
16	in the state of Louisiana would be beneficial; and
17	WHEREAS, solar and wind technology are emerging sources of energy and will
18	become increasingly important to provide the energy resources needed for current and future
19	generations and for the prosperity of our state and the nation.
20	THEREFORE, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana requests
