RE NO IMPACT See Note

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Provides relative to recall petitions

Proposed law requires the Secretary of State to provide the chairman and vice chairman representing the petitioners of a recall a document providing general information on petition requirements and deadlines. Proposed law requires each Registrar of Voters indicate which names appear on the petition but are not electors of the voting area. Registrars can request the assistance of the Department of State to complete the certification of the recall petition. Proposed law also provides for new timelines for recall petitions certification and clarifications on public records of the recall petition.
