## **GREEN SHEET REDIGEST**

HB 235 2024 Regular Session Coates

PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS: Increases the dollar amount for the exception to public bid law applicable to the purchase of vehicles by local government units.

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## **DIGEST**

<u>Present law</u> provides an exception for purchase by a local government unit or fire service of a new motor vehicle for conversion into a law enforcement vehicle that does not exceed the purchase price of \$40,000.

<u>Present law</u> requires that purchases by a local government unit or fire services of new motor vehicles for conversion into law enforcement vehicles or fire fighting or rescue apparatus that exceed the price of \$40,000 must be advertised and let out for bid.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the exception amount in <u>present law from</u> \$40,000 to \$70,000 per vehicle.

(Amends R.S. 38:2212.1(A)(2)(a))

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation</u>, <u>Highways and Public Works</u> to the <u>original bill</u>:

- 1. Add back the <u>present law</u> exception removed under the <u>proposed law</u> and increase the amount for purchase by a local government unit of a new motor vehicle for conversion into a law enforcement vehicle <u>from</u> \$40,000 <u>to</u> \$70,000 before the purchase must be advertised and let out for bid.
- 2. Adds fire fighting services.
- 3. Make technical changes.
