A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recognize April 14-20, 2024, as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, emergencies that require police, fire, or emergency medical services can occur at any time; when these emergencies occur, the prompt response of police officers, firefighters, and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

WHEREAS, the safety of police officers, firefighters, and paramedics is dependent on the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who contact Louisiana's emergency communications centers; and

WHEREAS, public safety telecommunicators monitor the activities of police officers, firefighters, and paramedics and provide them with information to ensure their safety; these centers contribute substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana's public safety dispatchers have exhibited compassion, understanding, and professionalism in the performance of their duties, and these individuals are most deserving of the highest recognition for their incredible service.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize April 14-20, 2024, as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in Louisiana and does hereby extend immense gratitude to the men and women whose diligence and professionalism has kept the state and its citizens safe.
