**Abstract:** Urges the Public Service Commission to explore excluding from the definition of public utility persons or corporations that furnish electricity to charge marine vessels and power points.

Present law provides that it is the intent of the legislature to promote rapid development of a statewide electric vehicle charging network. Present law additionally urges the Public Service Commission to explore excluding certain persons or corporations from the definition of public utility.

Proposed law retains present law and adds persons or corporations that furnish electricity exclusively to charge marine vessels and vessel-mounted or on-shore power points that are primarily used for marine vessels.
