Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by (\$22,873,163); Interagency Transfers by \$2,774,288; Fees and Self-generated Revenues by \$32,002,745; Statutory Dedications by \$246,065,314; and Federal Funds by (\$496,155,877).

Appropriates \$32,543,744 of State General Fund (Direct) of non-recurring revenue out of the surplus from Fiscal Year 2022-2023 for the Initial Unfunded Accrued Liability in state retirement systems.

Appropriates \$9,536,000 of State General Fund (Direct) of non-recurring revenue out of the surplus from Fiscal Year 2022-2023 for certain capital outlay projects. Provides that any appropriation contained in <u>proposed law</u> shall be deemed a bona fide obligation through June 30, 2025.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
