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Provides relative to the members of the Louisiana State Racing Commission

Proposed legislation provides for a per diem at the rate of \$100 per day while attending official meetings, regular or special, of the commission called by the chairman, or in his absence, one of the vice chairmen, not to exceed \$4,000 per annum.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation will result in a maximum exposure of \$26,000 in SGR expenditures in the Louisiana State Racing Commission, associated with reimbursement to members for expenditures incurred in the discharge of official duties. Proposed measure increases the per diem received by members from \$50 to \$100 per day while attending official meetings and increases the annual amount allowed from \$2,000 to \$4,000.

The \$26,000 increase in maximum exposure to the Louisiana State Racing Commission is calculated as follows:

Proposed law (13 members x \$4,000 maximum = \$52,000)
 Current law (13 members x \$2,000 maximum = \$26,000)
 Less = \$26,000 Increase
