Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Retirement to Reengrossed House Bill No. 15 by Representative Fontenot

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "R.S.11:2220(A)(2)(a)" and insert "R.S. 11:2213(11)(a)(iii) and
3 2220(A)(2)(a)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 13, delete "R.S.11:2220(A)(2)(a) is" and insert "R.S. 11:2213(11)(a)(iii) and
6 2220 (A)(2)(a) are"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, between lines 18 and 19, insert the following:

9 (a) * * *

11 (iii) Any person ~~in a position as defined in the municipal fire and~~
12 ~~police civil service system~~ who is employed on a full-time basis by a police
13 department of any municipality of this state, who is under the direction of a
14 chief of police, and who ~~is paid from the budget of the applicable police~~
15 ~~department~~ does not meet any other definition of employee."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 4

18 On page 2, at the end of line 13, change "March 5," to "June 30,"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 5

20 On page 2, at the beginning of line 14, change "2023," to "2024,"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 6

22 On page 3, delete lines 22 through 28, and insert the following:

24 "(4)(a) The retirement benefit of a retiree of this system who retired
25 on or before January 1, 2024, and who, before July 1, 2028, becomes an
26 employee, as defined by R.S. 11:2213, no sooner than ninety days following
27 the effective date of his retirement shall not be suspended as otherwise
28 required by Paragraph (2) of this Subsection if the retiree retired with twenty-
29 five years of service credit or retired with twenty or more years of service
30 credit and has attained the age of fifty-five."

31 AMENDMENT NO. 7

32 On page 4, after line 26, add the following:

33 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the
34 governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for
35 bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article
36 III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor
37 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective
38 on the day following such approval."
