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Requests a joint subcommittee of the House Committee on Appropriations and Senate Committee on Finance to study and make recommendations relative to state supplemental pay

Proposed resolution requests the chairmen of the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance to appoint a joint subcommittee to study and make recommendations for proposed legislation and policy changes related to state supplemental pay for local law enforcement and fire protection officers in Louisiana. The joint subcommittee is composed of six members. The resolution authorizes the joint subcommittee to conduct public hearings and request research, documents, or data from various state agencies, tribes, and local governmental subdivisions as necessary. The joint subcommittee is required to report its findings and recommendations to the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance no later than March 1, 2025.

The joint subcommittee is composed of six members.

To the extent that the Committee meets outside of session, legislators will receive per diem and travel expenses. The current legislative per diem is \$166 and the cost of related benefits (7.65% FICA tax) is approximately \$13 for a daily cost of approximately \$179 or \$1,074 (\$179 X 6 members) per day.
