Seabaugh

Present law provides for the termination of a public health emergency when the governor determines that the threat of danger has passed or the disaster or emergency has been dealt with to the extent that the emergency conditions no longer exist.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law authorizes the legislature, in consultation with the public health authority, to terminate a public health emergency by a petition signed by a majority of the surviving members of either house, and requires the governor to issue an executive order or proclamation ending the public health emergency.

Proposed law deletes the requirement that the legislature consult with the public health authority, and otherwise retains present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
