CEMETERIES: Regulates the operation of abandoned cemeteries.

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> permits a municipal or parochial government to abate a public health or safety risk of an abandoned cemetery when the cemetery is located within the jurisdiction of that municipal or parochial government.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the abatement of such risk shall take place at the sole and complete discretion of the governing body upon a majority vote.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall not be interpreted to authorize the disturbance of any graves or the moving or removal of human remains or grave markers.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that when exposed human remains are found during abatement activities, the municipal or parochial government or a volunteer who is undertaking the abatement shall notify the appropriate state authorities in accordance with <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that in the event of a declared disaster, the parish president or the chief elected official of a municipality may abate any public safety risk or public health hazard in a public or private cemetery caused by the declared disaster.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial delay.

- 2. Makes technical changes.
