Abstract: Provides for the financial security of surviving spouses and dependent children of a firefighter employed by certain federal agencies and killed in the line of duty.

<u>Present law</u> provides for payment of \$250,000 to the surviving spouse, child, or other beneficiary of a fireman who suffers death as a result of an injury arising out of and in the course of the performance of his official duties or arising out of any activity in his capacity as a fireman in the protection of life and property. Specifies the paid and volunteer firemen to whom <u>present law</u> is applicable.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands the applicability of <u>present law</u> to include any firefighter employed or under the control of one of the following federal agencies if the injury that resulted in the death occurred in La.:

- (1) Dept. of Defense.
- (2) Dept. of Veterans Affairs.
- (3) Dept. of Agriculture.
- (4) Dept. of the Interior.
- (5) Federal Emergency Management Administration.

Proposed law applies retroactively to Aug. 1, 2023.

## The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Make <u>proposed law</u> applicable to firefighters employed by or under the control of the U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs.
