Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed House Bill No. 759 by Representative Robby Carter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the end of line 3, after "Court;" and before "and to" insert "to provide for 3 effectiveness;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, after line 9, insert the following:

6 "Section 2.(A) The provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective if and 7 when a work point study by the National Center for State Courts is completed in accordance 8 with House Concurrent Resolution No. 39 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Louisiana 9 Legislature and the work point study concludes the additional district court judgeship is 10 necessary.

(B) The provisions of this Section shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, the provisions of this Section shall become effective on the day following such
