HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Bamburg to Engrossed House Bill No. 762 by Representative Bamburg

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "assessments;" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3
3 through 5 and insert "to exempt certain students from end-of-course testing requirements;
4 to require the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to adopt rules relative to
5 such exemption; and to"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 17 and insert the following:

8 "(g)(i) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Subsection or any
9 provision of law to the contrary, a student who attains a minimum score as
10 determined by the state board on both the English section and mathematics
11 section of the ACT shall be exempt from end-of-course testing requirements.

12 (ii) The state board shall adopt rules to provide for the
13 implementation of Item (i) of this Subparagraph, which shall provide for, at
14 a minimum, the following:

15 (aa) The minimum scores on the English and mathematics sections
16 of the ACT a student shall attain in order to be eligible for the exemption.

17 (bb) The measurement of growth in student achievement as measured
18 by the ACT for students who are exempt from end-of-course testing for
19 purposes of the school and district accountability system and the evaluation
20 of teachers and administrators.
