- (4)(a) As used in this Chapter, a "person" requesting a public record from a public body means an individual domiciled in the state or an individual who owns immovable property or resides in the state.
- (b) Notwithstanding Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, no applicant for a public record shall be prohibited from access to local government records, records of any law enforcement agency, any information or historical documents in the custody of the libraries or archives of the state, any vital statistics, vital records, criminal records, civil records, mortgage records, conveyance records, insurance records, or any other record held by a clerk of court or an equivalent custodian of records, or any publicly available information that an applicant may access using an online portal designed for such a purpose by a custodian of records, except as otherwise provided by law.

§4. Applicability

This Chapter shall not apply:

(64) To any record of the office of the governor pertaining to the schedule of the governor or the governor's spouse or child that contains security details that if made public may impair the safety of the governor, his spouse, or his child.

For purposes of this Subsection, "sufficient information" shall include any electronic or physical document or identification card which includes the requestor's name, age, and photograph.
    - (2) Any document submitted to establish the age and identification of a person pursuant to this Subsection shall not be a public record pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter and shall be immediately destroyed after completion of the verification process.
    - (3) This Subsection shall not apply to any state, local, or municipal political subdivision where a custodian of records has elected to establish a system to group, streamline, and assist in the exercise of the right to request, inspect, copy, reproduce, or otherwise obtain public records.
