HCR 5 2024 Regular Session Bayham

MTR VEHICLE/LICEN PLATES: Directs the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to imprint "America 250" on license plates for private passenger motor vehicles

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Senate Transportation, Highways, and Public Works Committee reported the bill with amendments to change the resolution <u>from</u> a direct <u>to</u> an urge and request that were subsequently removed on the Senate floor.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Urges and requests the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to imprint the "America 250" logo on official license plates for private passenger motor vehicles in accordance with a design developed by the America 250 La. State Commission. Provides for the department to begin issuing plates no later than Jan. 2, 2025, and continue to issue the plates through Dec. 31, 2026, or until the inventory of such plates is depleted, whichever is later. Specifies that after Dec. 31, 2026, the license plate design will revert to the design which received legislative approval as required in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 47:463(A)(3)) through passage of House Concurrent Resolution No. 121 of the 2004 R.S. of the Legislature.
