1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete line 2 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

3 "To amend and reenact R.S. 37:582 and 586(A)(1) and (2) and to enact R.S. 37:563(18) and
4 (19), 575(A)(18), and 595(B)(9), relative to"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 4, after "board;" insert "to provide for examination requirements; to provide
7 for definitions;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, delete line 5 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

10 "cosmetology schools; to outline the hours of instruction needed for a hair design"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, delete lines 8 and 9 in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

13 "Section 1. R.S. 37:582 and 586(A)(1) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted
14 and R.S. 37:563(18) and (19), 575(A)(18), and 595(B)(9) are hereby enacted to read as
15 follows:"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 1, in between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:

18 "§563. Definitions
19 As used in this Chapter, the following words have the following meanings:
20 * * *
21 (18) "Hair design" means the practice of arranging, dressing, cutting,
22 trimming, styling, shampooing, permanent waving, chemical relaxing, straightening,
23 curling, bleaching, lightening, coloring, mustache and beard design, and superficial
24 skin stimulation of the scalp.
25 (19) "Hair designer" means a person licensed in accordance with this
26 Chapter to engage in the practice of hair design.
27 * * *"

28 AMENDMENT NO. 6

29 On page 1, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following:

30 "§582. Qualifications for certificate as a registered cosmetologist, hair designer,
31 esthetician, or manicurist; out-of-state licensees

1 A. In order to receive a certificate of registration as a registered
2 cosmetologist, hair designer, esthetician, or manicurist, a person shall, in addition to
3 the requirements set forth in Subsection B of this Section, meet all of the following
4 requirements:

5 (1) Be at least sixteen years of age.

6 (2) Have, at the time of completion of the required schooling, the equivalent
7 training as would be contemplated in the satisfactory completion of the tenth grade
8 from an approved high school.

9 (3) Have satisfactorily passed an examination conducted by the board to
10 determine his fitness to receive a certificate of registration.

11 (4) Have paid the appropriate fee set forth in R.S. 37:599.

12 B. In addition to the requirements set forth in Subsection A of this Section,
13 a person shall also meet the following requirements in order to obtain his certificate
14 of registration as a registered cosmetologist, hair designer, esthetician, or manicurist:

15 (1) To obtain a certificate as a registered cosmetologist, a person shall have
16 completed and passed a course at a registered or licensed school of cosmetology
17 approved by the board.

18 (2) To obtain a certificate as a registered esthetician, a person shall have
19 completed and passed an esthetics course at a registered or licensed school of
20 cosmetology approved by the board.

21 (3) To obtain a certificate as a registered manicurist, a person shall have
22 completed and passed a manicuring course at a registered or licensed school of
23 cosmetology approved by the board.

24 (4) To obtain a certificate as a registered hair designer, a person shall have
25 completed and passed a hair designing course at a registered or licensed school of
26 cosmetology approved by the board.

27 C. The board shall issue the appropriate certificate of registration to any
28 person who possesses a license or certificate of registration to practice as a
29 cosmetologist, hair designer, esthetician, or manicurist from another state or from a
30 foreign country and who also meets the following requirements:

31 (1) Has completed and passed the appropriate course of study at a school
32 which is licensed in the state or country which issued the license.

33 (2) Has satisfactorily passed the ~~appropriate examination conducted by the~~
34 ~~board~~ national interstate council of state boards of cosmetology, or NIC, written and
35 practical examinations to determine his fitness to receive the certificate of
36 registration.

37 (3) Has paid the appropriate fee set forth in R.S. 37:599."

39 §586. Examination of applicants

40 A.(1) The examination team and testing service contracted by the board shall
41 conduct examinations of applicants for certificates as registered cosmetologists, hair
42 designers, estheticians, manicurists, teachers, and for any special permit issued by
43 the board which requires testing at such times and places as deemed appropriate by
44 the board.

45 (2) Practical cosmetologist, hair design, Louisiana state theory, and national
46 theory examinations shall be conducted at least twice monthly.

48 AMENDMENT NO. 7

49 On page 2, delete lines 4 through 9 in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

50 "* * *

51 (9) A course of practical training and technical instruction extending over a
52 period of not less than seven consecutive months and including not less than one
53 thousand hours for the basic course of hair design leading to a hair design certificate
54 sufficient to apply for licensure in hair design. The course of study shall include
55 lectures, discussion, instructions, and mechanical application."
