



1           WHEREAS, Drew Brees led the Saints to numerous achievements during his tenure,  
2 including top-five finishes in points scored and in total offense multiple times, as well as  
3 claiming seven National Football Conference (NFC) South titles and securing nine playoff  
4 appearances; and

5           WHEREAS, Drew Brees' leadership and skill were instrumental in leading the Saints  
6 to three NFC championship games and securing their first and only Vince Lombardi trophy  
7 with a victory in Super Bowl XLIV on February 7, 2010; and

8           WHEREAS, Drew Brees holds numerous NFL records, including career passing  
9 yards, touchdowns, completions, and attempts, showcasing his unparalleled talent and  
10 precision as a quarterback; and

11           WHEREAS, Drew Brees' impact extended beyond statistics, as he was a two-time  
12 NFL Offensive Player of the Year, a recipient of the Walter Payton Man of the Year award,  
13 and recognized for his contributions both on and off the field by Sports Illustrated and the  
14 Associated Press; and

15           WHEREAS, Drew Brees' accomplishments include five 5,000-yard passing seasons  
16 and ten seasons with at least thirty touchdowns, along with sharing the NFL single-game  
17 record for seven touchdown passes; and

18           WHEREAS, Drew Brees set a new standard of consistency and excellence in the  
19 NFL, breaking Johnny Unitas's record for consecutive games with a touchdown pass, a  
20 streak that reached an impressive fifty-four games.

21           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
22 commend Drew Brees on being inducted into the 2024 class of the Louisiana Sports Hall of  
23 Fame.

24           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to Drew  
25 Brees.
