Amendments proposed by Senator Jackson-Andrews to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 313 by Senator Edmonds

## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2	On page 14, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:
3	"§4037.13. State content standards; state testing
4	A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a
5	participating nonpublic school shall provide instruction in accordance with the
6	state content standards promulgated by the state Board of Elementary and
7	Secondary Education, but may utilize instructional material of their own
8	choosing.
9	B. A participating nonpublic school shall ensure that participating
10	students are administered all examinations required pursuant to the school and
11	district accountability system at the prescribed grade level, including the end
12	of course test that is administered to public school students. The results of the
13	test shall be provided to the parent.
14	C. A scholarship cohort index that is calculated in a manner that is
15	substantially similar to the school performance score outline in Bulletin 111, as
16	promulgated by the state Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, shall
17	be produced for each participating nonpublic school after the school year in
18	which assessments are taken. The scholarship cohort index shall measure only
19	the participating students who are enrolled in the nonpublic school.
20	D. The scholarship cohort index and the corresponding letter grade using
21	the scale applicable to school performance scores for each participating
22	nonpublic school shall be posted on the website maintained by the department
23	and otherwise published in the same manner as the annual school performance
24	score that is attributable to public schools.
25	E. If the participating nonpublic school receives a scholarship cohort
26	index less than fifty on a scale of one hundred and fifty in the second year of
27	participation or in any year thereafter, the school shall not enroll any additional
28	participating students.
29	F. If a participating nonpublic school for three consecutive years receives
30	a scholarship cohort index below fifty, the nonpublic school shall be ineligible
31	to participate in the program in the subsequent year.
32	G. A participating nonpublic school shall perform all screeners and other
33	testing mandated to be administered to any public school student, including but
34	not limited to the literacy screener required in R.S. 17:24.9."
