Subject: Study Taxes and Fees of Active-Duty Service and Veterans

REVENUE DEPARTMENT OR +\$3,855 GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1

Requests the Department of Revenue to study state and local taxes and vehicle registration fees collected from active-duty military and veterans.

Proposed resolution requests the Department of Revenue (LDR), Department of Public Safety and Corrections (DPSC), the Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV), and the LA Uniform Local Sales Tax Board (LULSTB) to jointly conduct a study regarding the collection of state and local taxes and vehicle registration fees from active-duty service members, retired veterans, and their spouses. The study is to include current sales and use exemptions or exlusions and potential changes in statutory law that incentivize active-duty members and veterans to locate in LA. LDR is to engage, collaborate with, and obtain information and recommendations from the LA Department of Veteran Affairs (LDVA). LDR is to submit a report of their findings and recommendations to the Senate Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs on or before January 8, 2025.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The resolution requests LDR to coordinate with DPSC, OMV, and LULSTB to study state and local taxes and fees (including title and vehicle registration fees) paid by active-duty service members, veterans, and their spouses and recommend potential changes in statutory law to provide incentives to attract military personnel to the state. LDR did not respond to a request for information.

The proposed resolution is anticipated to increase \$3,855 SGF expenditures in the OMV in FY 25. DPS reports the service type of exemptions being requested are not currently tracked by the OMV databases. If programatic changes to the vehicle registration system are required by the bill, DPS would incur an increase \$3,855 SGF expenditures. These costs are associated with 1 IT Senior Developer. The programming work would create a flag code for each service type in order to begin tracking sales and use tax collections and registration collections for service members, veterans, and their spouses.


The report is to be submitted to the Committees but does not require approval, thus there are no per diem payments directly associated with the resolution.
