WILDLIFE & FISHERIES: Urges and requests the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to study ways to develop and enhance recreational opportunities for certain portions of Little River

A RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to study ways to develop and
enhance recreational opportunities for certain portions of Little River.
WHEREAS, the Little River is a ninety-six mile long tributary of the Ouachita River
in central Louisiana; and
WHEREAS, the Little River is a Natural and Scenic River and is an area that is rich
in natural resources and offers fishing and boating, hunting and trapping, camping, hiking,
and many other benefits; and
WHEREAS, a portion of Little River is classified as a Wildlife Management Area
that is protected for the conservation of wildlife and for recreational activities involving
wildlife; and
WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 1 of the Constitution of Louisiana specifically
indicates that "the natural resources of the state, involving air and water, and healthful
scenic, historic and aesthetic quality of the environment shall be protected, conserved, and
replenished"; and
WHEREAS, fluctuations in the river levels impact public access to the river for much
of the year, and the low water levels make it virtually unnavigable and inaccessible to
recreational fishermen; and
WHEREAS, the study conducted by the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries shall,
at a minimum, include the following:

1	(1) An examination of how hydrological control structures and practices impact that
2	portion of Little River above the Little River Basin, including the impact on the populations
3	of largemouth bass, spotted bass, and crappie, and how increased control of water levels on
4	the river could potentially create additional opportunities for residential development along
5	the river.
6	(2) An examination of the inclusion of Little River, Big Creek, Fish Creek, and
7	Trout Creek on the Scenic River list.
8	(3) An examination of the improvement and development of new recreational
9	opportunities for the public such as fishing, camping, hunting, and hiking, as well as
10	identification of potential locations for boat launches, parks, and fishing piers.
11	(4) An examination of the current health of Little River and its tributaries with
12	regards to water quality and pollution.
13	(5) A study on the health and population of the sport fish population.
14	(6) An examination of the viability of construction of a weir on the river.
15	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
16	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Wildlife and
17	Fisheries to study ways to develop and enhance recreational opportunities for certain
18	portions of Little River and to submit a written report of its findings to the House Committee
19	on Natural Resources and Environment prior to the 2025 Regular Session of the Legislature
20	of Louisiana.
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
22	secretary of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.
