Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to Reengrossed House Bill No. 833 by Representative Davis

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 4, line 20, after "patients" delete the remainder of the line and insert "relinquish  
3 their legal rights to their embryos through a legal agreement with a recipient or a fertility  
4 clinic,"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 4, at the beginning of line 21, delete "their parental rights for in utero implantation,"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 4, line 27, after "person" delete the remainder of the line and insert "in an embryo  
9 donation agreement."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 4, at the beginning of line 28, delete "rights."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 5, delete lines 11 through 27 in their entirety and insert the following:

14 "A. All civil actions against any qualified healthcare provider shall be  
15 brought pursuant to the Medical Malpractice Act provided by R.S. 40:1231.3 et. seq.  
16 and the Malpractice for Liability for State Services Act provided by R.S. 40:1237.1  
17 et. seq. All civil actions brought against a nonqualified healthcare provider shall be  
18 subject to civil liability based upon the applicable standard of care.

19 ~~B. Strict liability or liability of any kind including actions relating to~~  
20 ~~succession rights and inheritance shall not be applicable to any~~ No physician,  
21 ~~healthcare provider, hospital, in vitro fertilization clinic, laboratory personnel,~~  
22 ~~provider of products and services, or their agent who acts in good faith participates~~  
23 ~~in the screening, collection, conservation, preparation, fertilization, culture, transfer,~~  
24 ~~biopsy, thawing, warming, analysis, storage, transportation, or cryopreservation, or~~  
25 ~~any acts typically performed during the in vitro fertilization process of the human~~  
26 ~~ovum embryo fertilized in vitro for transfer to the human uterus shall be subject to~~  
27 ~~criminal prosecution except in cases where acts were made with criminal intent as~~  
28 ~~defined by R.S. 14:10. Any immunity granted by this Section is applicable only to~~  
29 ~~an action brought on behalf of the in vitro fertilized human ovum as a juridical~~
