1	A RESOLUTION
2	To express the sincere condolences of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the
3	passing of Zachary Funderburk, son, brother, friend, wildlife agent, and Christian.
4	WHEREAS, Zachary "Zac" Funderburk, a native of Louisiana, unexpectedly passed
5	away on March 22, 2024, at the young age of twenty-seven; and
6	WHEREAS, Zac attended Parkway High School in Shreveport, where he
7	distinguished himself as a standout wrestler and cross-country runner; and
8	WHEREAS, his exceptional work ethic and skill produced back-to-back state
9	wrestling championships and his being named the 2015 Shreveport Times Wrestler of the
10	Year; and
11	WHEREAS, Zac earned an athletic scholarship to Briar Cliff University in Sioux
12	City, Iowa, and after graduating high school in 2015, he competed at the college level for
13	four years as a Briar Cliff Charger; and
14	WHEREAS, Zac built an impressive resume as a collegiate wrestler. He was a
15	National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics National Championship qualifier, was
16	named First Team All-GPAC, broke a school record for technical falls, and finished his
17	distinguished career a single win short of All-American honors; and
18	WHEREAS, Zac had a life-long love for the outdoors and hunting and fishing,

passions he delighted in sharing with those close to him; and

WHEREAS, following college graduation, Zac was accepted into the United States
Marine Corps Officer Candidates School; and
WHEREAS, a back injury lead to his early medical discharge from the Marine Corps,
but God had another opportunity in store for Zac; and
WHEREAS, Zac entered the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries Law
Enforcement Academy and graduated as a member of its 35th class of cadets on March 29,
2023, becoming a commissioned wildlife agent assigned to the northern parishes; and
WHEREAS, as a wildlife agent, Zac was a natural, often observing to friends and
family, "I can't believe I get to do this for a living!"; and
WHEREAS, Agent Funderburk was known as an exemplary public servant who
protected the citizens of Louisiana and made a significant impact on both his fellow agents
and those he served; and
WHEREAS, those who know and love Zac will cherish their many memories of his
faith, selflessness, and infectious zest for life, and they will take solace in the wisdom of
Romans 8:18, which Zac proudly wore tattooed on his chest: "The pain that you've been
feeling cannot compare to the joy that's coming."

hereby honors the memory of Zachary Funderburk and extends its deepest condolences to
his family and loved ones.
