## Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Adds a definition for "hostile work environment dispute", "nondisclosure clause", and "sexual harassment dispute".
- 2. Makes technical changes.
- 3. Provides that a nondisclosure clause required by an employer, agreed to prior to a hostile work environment or sexual harassment dispute, shall not be judicially enforceable.
- 4. Provides that <u>proposed law</u> does not restrict the ability of an individual to enter into a confidential settlement agreement provided that the agreement is entered into after a report of hostility or harassment is filed, or a hostile work environment dispute or sexual harassment dispute has occurred.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "hostile work environment", "sexual harassment", "hostile work environment dispute", "nondisclosure clause", and "sexual harassment dispute".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a nondisclosure clause required by an employer, agreed to prior to a hostile work environment or sexual harassment dispute, shall not be judicially enforceable.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>proposed law</u> does not restrict the ability of an individual to enter into a confidential settlement agreement provided that the agreement is entered into after a report of hostility or harassment is filed, or a hostile work environment dispute or sexual harassment dispute has occurred.
