4 On page 1, line 12, after "if" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 13 through 16, and 5 insert: "the knowledge, skills, or abilities required for the position for which an applicant is applying can only reasonably be obtained through a course of study in pursuit of, and 6 culminating in the award of, a baccalaureate degree, as determined by the Department of 7 8 State Civil Service or the State Police Commission for classified positions or the appointing authority for unclassified positions or to management, higher-level positions, or positions 9 10 in a career progression group as defined by a Department of State Civil Service or State 11 Police Commission rule."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 3

13 On page 1, after line 16, insert:

14 "Section 3. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2025; if vetoed by the 15 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on

16 the day following such approval by the legislature or January 1, 2025, whichever is later."
