<u>Present law</u> provides for a 25% premium discount on automobile insurance policies for active duty military personnel, La. Air National Guard, and La. Army National Guard.

<u>Proposed law retains present law</u> but extends the 25% premium discount on automobile insurance policies to military reservists, retired military, and veterans with a disability rating of 50% or more.

<u>Present law</u> provides that active duty military, La. Air National Guard, and La. Army National Guard personnel are entitled to a credit that is to be applied toward the premium taxes imposed under <u>present law</u> in an amount equal to the discount provided.

Proposed law retains present law and extends present law application to military reservists.

<u>Present law</u> requires the commissioner of insurance to adopt rules and regulations that define and delineate active duty military, La. Air National Guard, and La. Army National Guard personnel who may receive the discount.

Proposed law retains present law and extends present law application to military reservists.

Effective Jan. 1, 2025.
