KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

CRIME/PUNISHMENT. Authorizes law enforcement to impound any vehicle used in a drag race, or other enumerated action or event, at the owner's expense, for fourteen days to gather evidence pertaining to the crime. (8/1/24)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Provide for fees owed by the driver of a rental vehicle impounded under proposed law.

<u>Present law</u> makes it a crime to drive a vehicle in a race, speed competition or contest, drag race or acceleration contest, test of physical endurance, exhibition of speed or acceleration, or for the purpose of making a speed record on public roads or on any publicly or privately owned property to which public access is not prohibited.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows certain law enforcement agencies in this state to impound a vehicle, at the owners expense, for up to 14 days to gather evidence pertaining to the offense.

Effective August 1, 2024.
