CULTURE/FRENCH: Provides relative to the membership of the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Decreases number of lieutenant governor appointments from two to one.
- 2. Increases number of appointments by the Acadiana Delegation of the legislature from one to two.
- 3. Changes a <u>present law</u> appointment by the United Houma Nation to make it an appointment on a rotating basis by one of three tribes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for the membership of the Council for the Development of French in La. (CODOFIL), consisting of 23 members. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the reconstitution of the council by making the following changes in the membership:

- (1) Replaces three members appointed by the La. section of the Assemblée des Parlementaires Francophones with the following:
 - (a) One member appointed by the lieutenant governor.
 - (b) Two members appointed by the Acadiana Delegation.
- (2) Replaces one member appointed by the La. Cultural Economy Foundation with one member appointed by La. Parents for French Immersion.
- (3) Replaces two members appointed by the council's Consortium of La. Colleges and Universities with the following:
 - (a) One member appointed by the council's Consortium of La. Colleges and Universities.
 - (b) One member appointed on a rotating basis by the presidents of the University of La. at Lafayette, McNeese State University, and Nicholls State University.
- (4) Replaces one member appointed by the United Houma Nation with the following:
 - (a) One member appointed on a rotating basis by the United Houma Nation, the Pointe-Au-Chien Indian Tribe, and the Jean Charles Choctaw Nation.

<u>Present law</u> provides for four members appointed by the La. Consortium for Immersion Schools. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and requires the appointment of two members who reside east of the Atchafalaya River and two members who reside west of the Atchafalaya River.
