- 2 On page 2, line 9, after "Section." insert "In no event shall the policy limits of an uninsured
- 3 motorist policy be less than the minimum liability limits required under R.S. 32:900, unless
- 4 economic-only coverage is selected as authorized in this Section. Such coverage need not
- 5 be provided in or supplemental to a renewal, reinstatement, or substitute policy when the
- 6 named insured has rejected the coverage or selected lower limits in connection with a policy
- 7 previously issued to him by the same insurer or any of its affiliates. The coverage provided
- 8 under <u>pursuant to</u> this Section may exclude coverage for punitive or exemplary damages
- 9 by the terms of the policy or contract. Insurers may also make available, at a reduced
- premium, the coverage provided under pursuant to this Section with an exclusion for all
- 11 noneconomic loss. This coverage shall be known as "economic-only" uninsured motorist
- 12 coverage. Noneconomic loss means any loss other than economic loss and includes but is
- 13 not limited to pain, suffering, inconvenience, mental anguish, and other noneconomic
- damages otherwise recoverable under the laws of this state."
