- 10 "B.(1) A pharmacist may dispense and administer up to a thirty day supply 11 of HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis and a twenty-eight day course of HIV post-12 exposure prophylaxis to any person age seventeen or older pursuant to rules promulgated by the department if there is no prescription drug order. 13 14 (2) A pharmacist may perform a rapid HIV test at the pharmacy in a private, 15 secured location or may order laboratory testing for HIV infection for any person age seventeen or older pursuant to rules promulgated by the department. 16 (3) A pharmacist shall administer any tests performed pursuant to this Section 17 18 in a private location within the pharmacy, and shall ensure patient confidentiality, 19 including storing all records and documents regarding a patient's test results for HIV in a secured location that is not easily accessible by other employees in the 20 21 pharmacy."
