| 9  | §1603.2. Port and harbor police                                                          |
| 10 | A. For purposes of this Section, the board of commissioners for any port                 |
| 11 | district whose territory includes a parish with a population of sixty-eight thousand     |
| 12 | to seventy-three thousand according to the latest federal decennial census and a         |
| 13 | parish with a population of fifty-seven thousand to fifty-seven thousand four hundred    |
| 14 | according to the latest federal decennial census The board may, in its discretion,       |
| 15 | appoint, fix salaries of, and pay port and harbor police. The port and harbor police     |
| 16 | may consist of any number of people of good character and citizens of the state who      |
| 17 | have completed a course certified by the Council on Peace Officer Standards and          |
| 18 | Training; however, no member shall be under eighteen years of age.                       |

| 20 | D. Any persons arrested by officers of the commission meeting the                        |
| 21 | requirements of Subsection A of this Section and the return of all warrants or           |
| 22 | processes served by these officers shall be surrendered or delivered to the criminal     |

This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 7 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 8 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 9 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 10 effective on the day following such approval.
